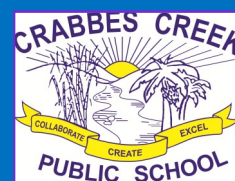

Kris explained lots of interesting things to us, such as how the leaves (e.g. Blue Fig) fall from the trees and provide food for the water bugs. 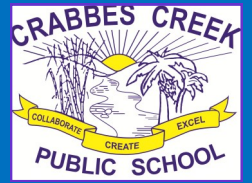
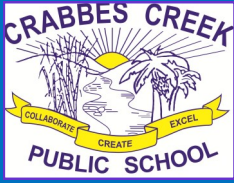
